

# PORTALS

## Spring Juried Exhibit

May 1<sup>st</sup> - June 27<sup>th</sup>, Reception May 2<sup>nd</sup>

THEME: Portals are not just doors and windows. Consider entryways, archways, eyes, alleys, pathways, negative space, wormholes, mirrors, drains, tunnels, gates, a way in or a way out, porticoes, inlets, hatches, rabbit holes, vestibules, trap doors, or crevasses.

JUROR: To be determined

LOCATION OF EXHIBIT: The ArtHub Gallery, 30 Temple Street (Lower Level), Nashua, NH 03060

ELIGIBILITY: Open call to all artists. Only original work by the artist will be allowed. If the work in question does not reflect the artist's personal style as demonstrated by their body of work, then the validity of the work being "original" needs to come into question. Work completed from a reference piece provided by an instructor is not considered original. Student work done under the supervision of an instructor will not be accepted.

NAAA reserves the right to reject any work that does not fit the theme of the show, as well as work that does not conform to the standards of good taste or suitability for public viewing.

WORK REQUIREMENTS: Artists may enter up to 4 works in any 2D or 3D-sculpture medium. Framing must be professionally presented and wired, if applicable. ***No saw tooth or keyhole hangers will be accepted for this exhibition. "Easel" style frames designed for tabletop use will not be accepted, even if wired.*** Failure to meet the hanging requirements will result in your work being rejected for this exhibition.

Please Note: Free standing 3D works may not exceed 8' high x 3' wide x 3' long. Work over 40 lbs. or that requires special installation handling must be installed by the artist.

ENTRY FEE: There will be an entry fee of \$5 per submission for members and \$10 per submission for non-members. Artists may submit up to 3 pieces for consideration.

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS: A reminder that members of NAAA are required to sign up to gallery sit.

APPLICATION: Deadline for online submissions will be April 17<sup>th</sup>. Please see the NAAA Gallery website for more details: [www.NAAA-ArtHub.org/submit](http://www.NAAA-ArtHub.org/submit). Please note that we will no longer be accepting paper registrations.

SALES: NAAA will take standard commission for members as cited in the NAAA artist contract on all sales of members' artwork. A 30% commission will be taken for non-members' artwork sold during the show. All works submitted to the show must be for sale.
